Re: Official Information Act request – Parking fees

I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 7 October 2019 requesting the following information.

I wish to make a request for information under the Official Information Act 1982.

The amount of money Auckland DHB has made from parking fees from January 1 2017 until today (7/10/19). Could I have this information laid out in a table showing fees generated from each parking building/area per year.

Auckland DHB does not directly receive revenue from paid public and staff parking.

Revenue from parking is collected by AMP from Wilson carparking. AMP in turn pays an annual fee to Auckland DHB. The fee collected from parking for the period January 2017 to September 2019 (33 months) was \$14,123,000. Income for current month (Oct 19) is not available.

Please Note Auckland DHB does not separate fees paid by carpark.

Auckland DHB applies the revenue to maintaining related assets and services such as hospital campus roads linking car parking, providing new car park facilities, and maintaining existing onsite and offsite parking.

I trust this information answers your questions.
