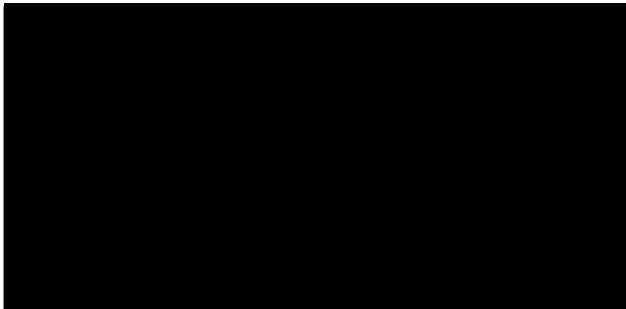

**Re Official Information Request – CPR Statistics in hospital**

I refer to your official information request dated 18 July 2020 to the MoH. The MoH have transferred question 4 of your request to Auckland DHB. You requested the following information:

**I would also appreciate any information available on CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) statistics in hospital - the number of times this has been performed in the Auckland region in the last 2 years and demographic of the people in which this was performed on (age, ethnicity).**

The data supplied here refers to in-hospital cardiorespiratory arrests (absence of circulation or respiration requiring cardiopulmonary resuscitation) at Auckland City Hospital over the period of June 1 2018 to May 31 2020.

We are unable to provide figures for the Auckland region as we only capture in-hospital data.
