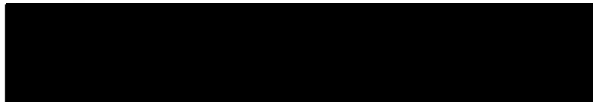

**Re Official Information Request – Ruby Princess Visit**

I refer to your official information request dated 7 April 2020 requesting the following information:

**Can you please provide copies of all documentation (including notes, memos, reports, forms etc) held by the DHB in relation to the Ruby Princess's planned visit to Auckland on March 17 (which did not occur). This includes documentation sent to or from the ship in the five days preceding the ship's visit, and the time since its visit.**

I am responding from Auckland District Health Board (ADHB) as the DHB responsible for Auckland Regional Public Health Service (ARPHS).

ARPHS provides public health services to all three metro Auckland District Health Boards – Waitematā District Health Board, Counties Manukau Health and Auckland District Health Board, and the populations they serve. ARPHS's core role is to protect and promote public health.

Notwithstanding competing pressures on ARPHS with respect to COVID-19 the answers to your questions are as follows:

As the Ruby Princess did not proceed to Auckland no exchange of correspondence occurred other than on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2020 the Ruby Princess Administration Officer sent to ARPHS a copy of the Maritime Declaration of Health dated 16<sup>th</sup> March 2020. ARPHS checked the Ports of Auckland website prior to the anticipated arrival and found that the proposed visit to Auckland had been cancelled. No further actions occurred.

The above mentioned Maritime Declaration of Health is attached; however, all the personal details of individuals have been redacted (under section 9 (2) (a) of the Official Information Act 1982) in order to protect the privacy of natural persons.

I trust this is the information you were seeking.


