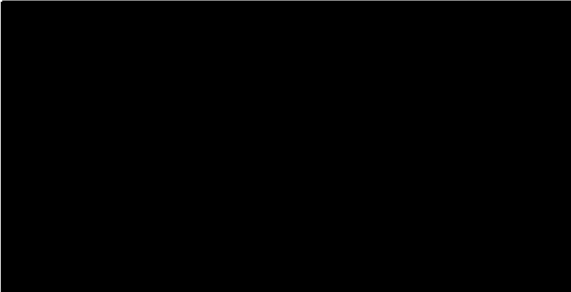

Re: Official Information Act request – Redundancies and fixed term contracts/smart infusions

I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 6 April 2021, requesting the following information:

1. Since the start of 2020 how many people have been made redundant at ADHB?

Since the start of 2020, 8 employees have been made redundant

2. How many fixed term contracts been terminated?

Since the start of 2020, 1197 fixed term contracts have been terminated

3. How many people have been employed as permanent staff?

There have been 1299 full time employees and 342 part time employees that were employed under a new permanent contract since 2020

4. How many fixed term contracts have been initiated?

Since the start of 2020, 1673 positions in fixed term employment started

5. How are your supplies of smart infusions, infusion sets, medications, and IV fluids?

6. Are any of your supplies at critical levels? If so, what, and when will they be restocked?

7. Are you able to replenish your above mentioned supplies easily?

We understand questions 5 through 7 have been responded to by the Ministry of Health on 7 April 2021.
