### Re: Official Information Request – Senior Chinese North Shore Residents Vaccination Data – Auckland DHB Ref: 20220610-1242

I refer to your official information request transferred to us by Waitematā DHB on 10 June 2022 requesting the following information:

## *"I am writing a report about the COVID-19 vaccination support provided to senior Chinese residents in North Shore Auckland.*

# I need vaccination data (rate) of this ethnic (Chinese) and age (65+) group from Oct in 2021 to May 2022 regarding 1st dose, 2nd dose and boost dose number monthly."

#### Response


I am responding on behalf of the Northern Region Health Coordination Centre (NRHCC), the COVID-19 response and vaccination team set up by the Northland, Waitematā, Auckland, and Counties Manukau District Health Boards (DHBs).

Please refer to the table below which includes the number of Chinese residents aged 65+ who live within the North Shore City Boundary and are enrolled in a PHO (Public Health Organisation), and received a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccination. This covers the period October 2021 to May 2022.

I am unable to retrospectively provide the rate of Chinese residents aged 65+ who live within the North Shore City Boundary and received the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccination as this information is not held by NRHCC.

I have included a map below of the North Shore City Boundary, used to determine residents currently domiciled in the area.
