## Your Official Information Act request, reference: 20220829-1292 Number plate recognition technology

Thank you for your email of 29 August, asking for the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

What databases are the cameras intending to feed into or reference from upon their installation?

## Response

Since responding to your initial request we have had confirmed that cameras installed to help manage traffic related to the current major infrastructure upgrade works on the Auckland City Hospital Grafton site have number plate recognition capability. While that capability is not currently activated, the plan is to use this capability to help manage contractor vehicles on site. Contractors on our site for the infrastructure works will provide information on their vehicles and will be asked to remove these vehicles if they are found to be parked on the Grafton site and are not meant to be. This data will be held within the system.

In relation to the cameras installed in carpark A, no decisions have been made on what data will be held or accessed. This will be determined as part of the privacy impact assessment.
